

First-ever Trolley and Boat Tour Showcases History and Beauty of Scenic Highway



You drive past the Old Chimney every day, admire the lovely panorama of water and bluffs and remind yourself that you need to revisit Bay Bluffs Park soon. But did you also know that some of 11-mile corridor's neighborhoods are named for historic points along the highway? Lora Point, Gaberonne, Gull Point, Bohemia. For the first time, the public will have an opportunity to learn

about these and more history and lore along the highway during the Scenic Highway Foundation's Trolley and Boat Tour on Saturday, October 13 from 1:45-7:00 p.m. The tour is a fundraiser to restore the Old Chimney as well as provide seed money for a much-needed biking and pedestrian path along the highway.

Attendees will park in one of the parking lots on Commendencia Street south of Main and board one of the 40-passenger trolleys waiting near the ferry dock at 1:45 p.m., departing promptly at 2 p.m. for a tour of the entire 11-mile corridor, which ends at the Santa Rosa causeway. Here we will turn around and start retracing our path while one of our board members recites a narrative about geology, the environment, brickmaking, sawmills, and all of the facets that make the highway so special. Next, we head to the Days Inn at Palafox and Cervantes to enjoy a wine and food reception and take about 15 minutes to conduct business during our annual meeting to update members of SHF and locals about current accomplishments and future endeavors. Then we again board the trolley and return to Commendencia Slip where we will board one of the Park Service's ferry boats and cruise up Pensacola and Escambia Bays for a scenic vista no one ever gets to see—our spectacular red clay bluffs from the water at sunset.
